The Organization

Green Africa foundation was founded in Kenya in the year 2000 with a focus of implementing practical community driven projects towards greening Africa. The organization has actively been implementing a number of projects covering; Climate Change, Policy Advocacy, Environmental Governance & Conservation, Agriculture, Water and Energy. The organization has been very instrumental in Environment & Climate Change Governance and Policy Advocacy that has seen through a number of policies coming to fruition both at the county and the national level and with agenda of climate change mainstreaming and improved governance at the county level taking precedence.

The Project

Green Africa Foundation, through support from KawiSafi, is conducting awareness creation and education to women on the benefits of adopting clean and renewable energy and related products and technologies in their daily lives especially in cooking and lighting; increase the adoption of these technologies and related products in the market through advocacy and sensitization; educate on the impacts of unclean energy such as kerosene to their health; cost repercussions; and the need to shift to cleaner, renewable and cheaper sources of energy.

The goal of this project is to have improved access and just transition to clean and renewable energy sources for household lighting to improve on health and socioeconomic status of households in Kitui County. This project targets women in the rural set ups, who together with children are the most vulnerable and impacted by climate change. Dirty fuels for cooking and lighting such as firewood, charcoal and kerosene have harmful effects on women and children's health.

This project is about empowering women with skills in exploitation and use of clean and renewable energy technologies and innovations. The objective of the proposed project is to educate women about the positive health benefits associated with replacing kerosene lighting with solar lighting. This entails awareness creation and capacity building on the importance of shifting from dirty sources of energy such as kerosene, firewood and charcoal to clean solar energy which is clean and renewable. The women shall be influenced to change their mind set and perceptions of their community towards climate change, its negative impacts and how they can adapt and become resilient.

To reach a bigger audience on capacity building, 20 TOT women shall be identified in Kitui County and they shall undergo a training on different aspects on the messages to pass to women groups and gatherings. The TOT women shall then support Green Africa Foundation in reaching out through targeted forums.
